REBIDs On Capacity

- **GOAL:**
 - Compliance with the North America Energy Standards Board (NAESB) standards to allow a transmission customer to negotiate for a lower amount of capacity when the Transmission Provider offers less capacity than what the customer originally requested.
- **In Scope:**
 - Short-term and Long-Term REBIDs on capacity.
- **Out of Scope:**
 - REBIDs on price (Customers will be charged the posted rate for service type).

How Is BPA Closing The Gap?

- On Feb. 6, 2018, BPA implemented the REBID functionality in the fully automated short-term market.
- March 14, 2018, BPA will post the following updated business practices (Red-line versions of the business practices will also be posted.)
 - Long-Term Firm Queue
 - Partial Long-Term Firm Service
 - Redirects
 - Requesting Transmission Service
 - TSR Procedures
 - Appendix A – SAMTS
- No later than March 31, 2018, BPA anticipates implementing the long-term functionality.
 - BPA staff evaluated how REBIDs would align with internal procedures and timelines associated with offering paper contracts to customers.

Benefits

- Provides additional market flexibility.
- Enables transmission customers to negotiate only the capacity needed.
- Enhances negotiation between BPA and the customer to provide a solution that better fits the customer's needs.
